A parish affiliated student is one from a family that is a participating member (spiritually & financially) of one of the 14 Vicariate Parishes that support Alleman High School. A non-parish affiliated student would either be non-Catholic or from a Catholic family not affiliated with a Vicariate Parish.

FEES

- **General Fee:** (*\$150/student*)
The general fee is non-refundable and pays for the student's school newspaper, yearbook, athletic pass, standardized testing, library services, school-loaned hard-bound textbooks and school sponsored religious retreats.
- **Diocesan Drug Screening Fee:** (*\$50/student*)
The DDS fee is non-refundable & pays for the student's drug screening test as required by the Diocese of Peoria.
- **Registration Fee:** (*\$25/student*)
A non-refundable fee that is due at the time of registration.
- **Technology Fee:** (*\$135/student – ANNUALLY*)
The Technology Fee is an **ANNUAL** fee for the use of a school issued Chromebook, associated academic resources and device security.
- **Art & Science Lab Fess:**
Certain Art & Science classes have fess associated with their class to cover expendable supplies used by students

BOOKSTORE PURCHASES

Depending on the courses your student is registered for, there may be additional materials to purchase through the school bookstore at the start of each semester (Examples: Foreign Language Workbooks or P.E. Clothes)

EDUCATION TAX CREDIT

Since the year 2000, the State of Illinois has offered an Illinois Education Tax Credit to parents with children in grades K-12 who spend more than \$250 a year on tuition, books or lab fees. Parents may claim up to 25% of the balance, up to \$500 per family per year. Eligible expenses are for the calendar year. The tax credit is applied to the parents State Tax Liability.
